

## 2020/21 Registration Terms and Conditions

1. All players registering to play senior men or senior women cricket must register before the first game if they wish to be valid for selection.
2. **Early Bird payment rates cut off on Sunday 25 October 2020** and arrangements for extension can only be made by the WCMCC Committee. Failure to do so will result in the player being moved to the applicable full rate and required to pay that full amount.
3. Players must have paid or be on an active payment plan by **25 November 2020** to be available for selection.
4. Upon registration with the WCMCC, members agree to abide by the **Cricket ACT handbook**, our **sponsorship agreements** and the club's **policies** as found at <http://www.wcmcc.org.au/>. Failure to comply may lead to the player being suspended.
5. Any player who is experiencing **financial hardship** and cannot pay the applicable full rate is able to approach the Registrar and/or President to negotiate a revised payment schedule. Agreement to such a schedule will only be made in exceptional and/or extenuating circumstances. If agreed to, the player concerned will be required to sign a formal, documented payment plan that will be signed by the player, the Registrar and witnessed by the Club President.
6. Players seeking to utilise **Student/ Apprentice/ Unemployment** rates, must provide proof of status to the Registrar upon initial registration.
7. The 20/21 Senior Men-WCMCC Junior rate only applies to WCMCC registered juniors. **Juniors from other clubs or school junior teams** must pay the normal student rate (on presentation of proof that they are students as per clause 6).
8. Players seeking the **20/21 Senior Men-WCMCC Junior** rate must provide proof from WCMCC juniors that they are registered and paid prior to registration with seniors.
9. The **Casual Player** rate of \$30 per game only applies for 6 game days during one season. Upon playing more than 6 games, players qualify for club membership and further payment will be sought.
10. Those players who may be unable to play a significant number of games of the season may approach the Registrar to negotiate a **pro-rata registration fee** for the season. This rate will be negotiated between the player and Registrar based on number of games played compared to number of games scheduled for a season.
11. Players registered for **20/21 Senior Men 5th Grade** may be called to play 4th grade or higher during the season due to the absence of players. These players will not be charged a higher fee as this will be classified as a 'by exception' arrangement.

12. If a player registered for **20/21 Senior Men 5th Grade** actively seeks to play higher grades during the season, the club may seek further payment after 6 games has been played in higher grades. The fee will be on a pro-rata basis based on number of games played.
13. Any player who elects to play only **20/21 Senior Men 5th Grade** and does not wish to be considered for selection in higher grades must make this position known to the club selectors at the commencement of the competition season or upon registering to join the club. The decision to be selected for the lower grades will be made on a case-by-case basis at the discretion of the club committee and selectors.
14. **Upon registration** with the club, **new players** will be given a WCMCC playing cap, a WCMCC training shirt, and a WCMCC playing shirt.
15. **WCMCC reserves the right to refuse registration to those seeking to play for the Club where the person concerned is listed on the NSW Cricket Association or Cricket ACT debtor blacklists**, until such a time as they have settled their debt with the club that originated the blacklisting and they are removed from said list. This prevents the person concerned from playing or training with the club in any form or manner until such a time as the issue is resolved.
16. **WCMCC past players who are annotated as club debtors** (regardless if they are on the formal NSW Cricket Association or Cricket ACT debtor blacklists) are not able to register to play or train in any form until such a time as they have;
  - a) paid their past debt in full, **and**
  - b) requested, and been granted, approval from the Club Committee to re-join the club
17. If approval is given by the Club Committee to the **WCMCC past debtors** to play for the Club they reserve the right to require the person to pay the full registration fee prior to being allowed to train or play for the Club.
18. Players **must** abide by the current government **COVID-19 legislation, Cricket ACT COVID-19 policies** and **WCMCC COVID-19 Action Plan**.
19. Should the season be **suspended** due to COVID-19, fees paid can be negotiated.
